

Hot Tub Terms of Use

Guests using a hot tub must read and follow these terms. By accepting the booking terms and conditions, you confirm that you have read and agree to the following:

1. Supervision & Use

- Children under 4 years old must not use the hot tub.
- Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.
- Keep the hot tub covered and secured when not in use.

2. General Health & Safety

- The hot tub is pre-set at 38°C. Do not increase the temperature.
- Pregnant women should not use the hot tub.
- Guests with heart disease, high blood pressure or diabetes should consult their doctor before use.
- Long hair should be tied back to avoid entanglement in filters or drains.
- Using the hot tub under the influence of alcohol or drugs is not advised due to risks such as drowning and impaired ability to regulate body temperature.
- Do not use electrical devices in or near the hot tub.
- Exit the hot tub immediately during lightning or adverse weather.
- Take care in winter, as splashed water can freeze and create slippery surfaces.
- The hot tub is treated with bromine and other standard pool chemicals. Guests with allergies to these chemicals must not use the hot tub.

3. Hygiene

- Always shower before use; showering after use is also advised.
- Guests wearing fake tan must not use the hot tub.
- Food and drink must not be taken into the hot tub.

4. Damage & Liability

- Guests are responsible for any damage caused to the hot tub and must report this to the owner immediately. Repair or replacement costs may be charged.
- Use of the hot tub is at guests' own risk. The owner accepts no responsibility for illness, allergic reactions, or injury resulting from its use.

5. Owner Access & Misuse

- The owner carries out a brief daily check of the hot tub. By booking, guests agree to allow access for this.
- The owner reserves the right to suspend use of the hot tub if safety, hygiene, or repeated misuse makes it necessary.
